

Community Garden & Corn Crib

At the Community Trail Farm, we are working to transform an existing historic corn crib into a vibrant hub for the future community garden space.

Currently, the corn crib sits in a wetland area where it cannot be fully utilized. The structure itself remains solid and structurally sound, but it needs basic repair and relocation in order to reach its full potential.

By relocating and repairing the corn crib to the Community Garden area, we unlock an opportunity to create a space that directly supports community connection, learning, and food access.


The Corn Crib Will Serve As:

- A space for education and hands-on workshops
- A gathering and shelter area for volunteers, school groups, and visitors
- Tool storage and operational support for garden activities
- A place to celebrate the diverse food traditions of our region
- A site that helps grow and share food with the community



Estimated Costs:

- \$7,500 relocation
- \$2,500 for repairs
- \$22,000 for concrete landing pad
- \$5,000 for garden tools
